- Grade 2 & Grade 5 used for the tube and internals
- Grade 2 & Grade 9 tube and pipe used for the cylinder

Benefits:

- Light-weight and ultra-corrosion resistant
- Keeps the end of barrel weight down



FIRING PINS

Titanium Used:

- Grade 5 Titanium

Benefits:

- Lighter weight accelerates faster
- Ultra-corrosion resistant, no coating needed



COMMON APPLICATIONS

TACTICAL MOUNTS

Titanium Used:

- Grade 5 often used for scope mounts and picatinny rails of the gun or the barrel

Benefits:

- Light-weight for ease of use
- Corrosion resistant & strong



CUSTOM KNIVES

Titanium Used:

- Grade 5 used for liners, clips, blades, pins, fasteners and locks

Benefits:

- When used in handles and locking mechanisms, creates solid base for the blades, without adding unnecessary weight
